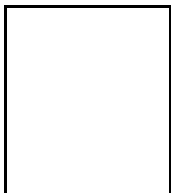

DEAR CONGREGANTS



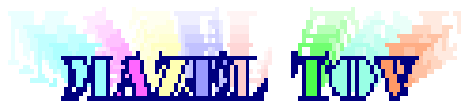

I had never heard of the man; the name meant nothing to me. As he rose out of his seat I could see that he was a short man, with white hair who walked to the stage as a veteran of the “wars” might do: With deference but at the same time with a spring to his step. As he reached the microphone his very first act, his very first words, were to look upward and say “thank you Mama, thank you Papa”. I thought it was almost a caricature of what a “nice Jewish boy” might say in gratitude as he was being presented with a prestigious award.

The name I did not recognize was Arthur Hiller, and I have no idea whether or not he is Jewish. It certainly does not matter. His award was the Jean Hersholt Humanitarian Award given at the Oscar ceremonies just a few weeks ago.

Again, I had never heard of the gentleman, nor were his Humanitarian achievements discussed in any detail. I suppose that the members of the Hollywood Community knew of him because the applause was resounding. In his response, however, I quickly saw the strength of this “little” man who was beginning to appear taller and deeper with each word he spoke. He voiced gratitude to his parents for what they had taught him and his sisters by precept and example. Then he spoke these simple words which, from now on, will serve to guide me as well. He said, “I really don’t know why they are giving an award for what should be the natural action of every human being”.

Whoever, whatever he is I stood converted. Would it not be a wonderful world, a wholesome society if all people would take his message to heart and live accordingly?

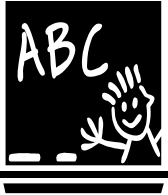

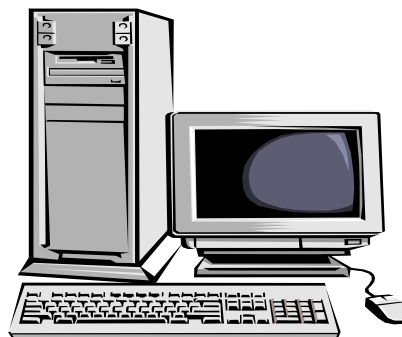
